### Types of Membership

Each Uniting Church keeps a roll of members. The Uniting Church recognises several different forms of membership

#### Baptised Members

This category most frequently includes children who have been baptised but also adults who have been baptised but not confirmed.

#### Confirmed Members

Confirmed members have undertaken a confirmation course and have been received by the church in a confirmation service in which they would normally make a public confession of their faith. Confirmed members are expected to acknowledge Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord, determine to follow him in their daily life, participate actively in the life of the church and in the extension of the Kingdom of God.

#### Members - in - Association

This category includes confirmed members of another Christian denomination who now participate actively in the life of our congregation and who have accepted the beliefs and practices of the Uniting Church. They would be received as part of a membership service. Members of other denominations who have not been confirmed but that were baptised as adults would also be received as Members - in - Association.

#### Adherents

In addition to a roll of members the church also keeps a roll of adherents. These are people who are not members but regularly attend worship and participate in the life of the church.
