If you are new or visiting Adelaide West Uniting Church we are pleased you are here. A Welcome to Adelaide West information sheet is available in the foyer or from the stewards.

In our services today we will focus on some of the farmer managed natural regeneration work that World Vision is doing in East Sumba. This sort of work is a practical outworking of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Gospel lectionary reading that is set for today is Mark 10.46-52 where Bartimaeus receives his sight. Despite Jesus repeating three times that he will be crucified the disciples never 'see' what Jesus is saying.

Bartimaeus, who cannot literally see, actually sees who Jesus is and cries out for mercy. When Jesus calls him he throws aside his begging mat, his tool of trade, a symbol that he trusts in Jesus. His encounter with Jesus leads to healing and Bartimaeus living without begging. Regeneration of land leads to people being able to live by their own work rather than being dependent on others. Such freedom is an aspect of the Kingdom of God and I rejoice that we can support it.
